BOARD IN BRIEF

CSCIA BOARD OF GOVERNORS MONTHLY MEETING FEBRUARY 15, 2009

The February 2010 CSCIA Monthly Board of Governors meeting was convened on February 15, 2010 at 7:30 P.M. in the Cape St. Claire Clubhouse, Cox Meeting Room.

President's Remarks:

President Gallagher

Introduced and welcomed two new members of the Board of Governors...Governors Michele Cesare and Matt Hetrick. Stated that legal actions are proceeding favorably for the CSCIA against a boat slip renter for delinquent rents and related payments.

Reported that a Cape Community Watch group submitted an application to the CSCIA to become a Cape Recognized Organization.

Minutes:

Minutes of the October 19, 2009 CSCIA Executive Committee meeting: Governor Daly made a motion to approve these minutes. Governor Ritenour seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Minutes of the December 28,

2009 CSCIA Special BOG meeting: Governor Mooneyhan made a motion to approve these minutes. Governor Ritenour seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Profit & Loss Statements (P&Ls):

November 30, 2009 Profit & Loss Statements: Governor Newman made a motion to approve these P&L Statements. Governor Daly seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

December 31, 2009 Profit & Loss Statements: Governor Newman made a motion to approve these P&L Statements. Governor Ritenour seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

January 31, 2010 Preliminary Profit & Loss Statements were discussed with no issues noted.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

-Beaches & Parks: Governor Newman reported that bulkhead repair project at Deep Creek is well underway and should be completed in about one month.

-Piers: President Gallagher commented that the bubbler system at Deep Creek was not put into operation because of

several hose breaks, disconnections and other related problems. The costs of replacement and other alternatives will need to be evaluated.

-Governor Ritenour: Reported that he attended the recent Anne Arundel County Police/Community Relations Council meeting on crime prevention held every third week of the month. The police expressed concern about the huge number of false security alarm reports being received. Of almost 31,000 security alarm reports received from homes and businesses, only 231 of those cases

were actual crimes. **99.2%** of the reported alarms were false alarms. ...**The police provided notice that effective January 1, 2010; a new law results in fees being charged against the alarm owners if the police arrive at the property.**

NEW BUSINESS:

Vice President Gardner reiterated that the Broadneck Council of Communities (BCC) monitors various activities on the Broadneck peninsula and that it would be beneficial if we had a Cape St. Claire representative on their Board of Governors. She further stated that a Cape resident, who is also a CSCIA employee, regularly attends these BCC meetings and has offered to serve as the Cape's

liaison. ...The BOG approved a motion approving his serving as our liaison to the BCC.

Attendance:

Governors Berley, Campbell, Cesare, Daly, Gallagher, Gardner, Hetrick, Mooneyhan, Newman and Ritenour were present. Governor Lamb was absent.

Adjournment: Vice President Gardner made a motion to adjourn the February 15, 2010 CSCIA BOG Monthly meeting. Governor Campbell seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved. The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 PM.

The End of Bella's Restaurant and Sportsbar

As most of you have probably heard by now Bella's Sportsbar & Seafood has closed its doors. Many Broadneck residents have known Bella's by its electric blue front and awning, the neon signs that hang in the windows and the smell of steamed crabs in the summer. But Bella's is a part of Cape St. Claire's history.

In 1947 there was a grocery store and bar where the Seafood store was located, owned by Howard Lawson. In 1951 he built the larger building and opened the Sand's Restaurant with another Cape resident Bill Bauman. In 1964 Bea Novosel

Smith and her husband CG Smith along with Bella Novosel (Bea's mother) bought the building from Howard's widow, Ellie Lawson. They opened Bella's Bee Hive. In 1966 they moved the bar area to where it was currently. In 1974 CG Smith then opened a Package Goods store where the old bar and store had been. In 1981 CG and Bea purchased the lots next to the restaurant to open Bella's Liquors.

In 1982 Bella's granddaughter Bonnie Morgan and her grandson Billy Novosel used the space that had been the Package Goods store and made it into a Seafood Store. There you could get fresh steamed crabs, oysters, clams etc. In 1985 Bea's daughter Valerie Sullivan took over running the bar. Bea

passed away in 1986.

In approximately 1988 Bonnie and her mother, Wanda Murray (Bella's older daughter) took over the bar. They changed the name from the Bee Hive to Bella's Restaurant and Seafood. Under their management the bar went through several changes; it was a restaurant with booths, a hostess, and steak and seafood entrees, a Karaoke bar, a pool hall with Sunday night tournaments, and a music venue where you could see bands such as Mary Lou and the Untouchables as well as Carey Ziegler's from Crack the Sky. She then put in a "Crab Garden" where you could enjoy all you can eat crabs at picnic tables. On any given weekend you might find a DJ, a band or just the Juke Box cranking out tunes. Owner Bonnie Morgan was always changing something to get customers to come in. Twenty-two years later, Bonnie and her mother have decided to retire and let someone else make their way in that space. They wish the new owner great success.

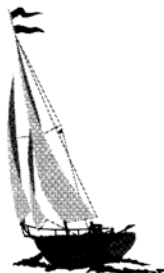

Awards will be presented to all finishers and individual awards

will be given to first and second place male and female finishers of the 5K race in designated age groups. We also encourage any Cape residents who are unable to race to come out and join the fun as spectators along the race course and cheer on the participants.

We are fortunate to once again have WNAV, AM 1430 broadcasting live before and during the race from the school.

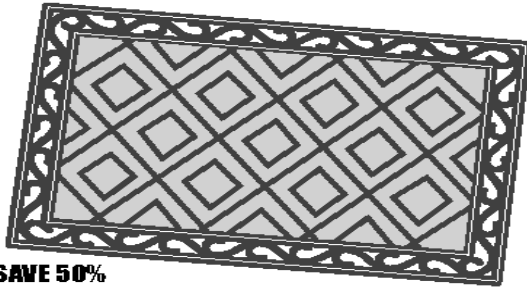

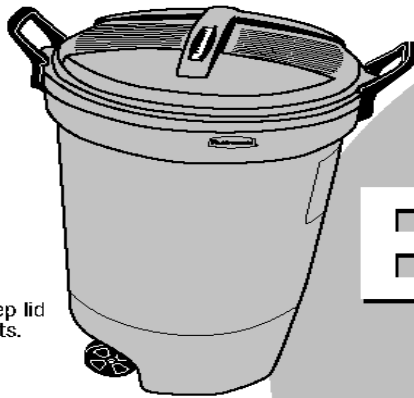
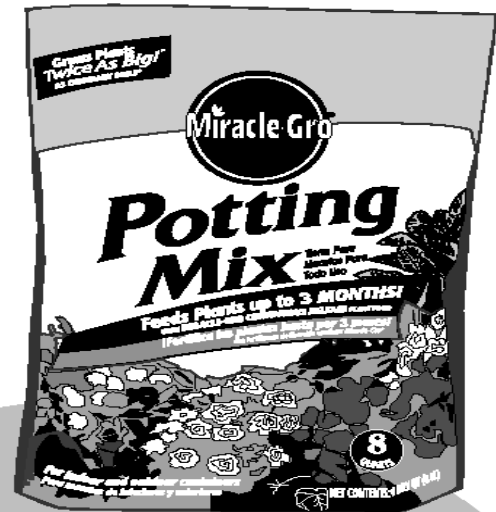
