BOARD IN BRIEF CSCIA BOARD OF GOVERNORS MONTHLY MEETING **OCTOBER 11, 2010**

The October 2010 CSCIA Monthly Board of Governors meeting was convened on October 11, 2010 at 7:30 P.M. in the Cape St. Claire Clubhouse, Cox Meeting Room.

President's Remarks: President Gallagher presented the agenda for the meeting and made brief opening remarks, including the fact that he received notification from the County that a resolution was introduced for the County to cast seven votes for the seven Cape lots they own - in favor of removing the abusive language from our CSCIA covenants.

Minutes and Profit & Loss Statements (P&Ls):

A motion was made and unanimously approved to accept the Minutes of the September 13, 2010 CSCIA Monthly BOG meeting. Another motion was made and approved to accept the August 31, 2010 Profit & Loss Statements.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Clubhouse: Governor Lamb reported that the clubhouse roof leaked extensively during the recent rainstorms. Indications are that a complete roof replacement needs to be considered at a very large expense.

Beaches & Parks: Governor Newman reported that new front gates were installed at the Main Beach area. These gates replaced the worn gates and allow easier control of pedestrian and vehicular traffic to the beach area.

Vice President Gardner:

Commented that the Candidate's Night held at the clubhouse on October 2nd was a fantastic success, and she complimented all of the organizers and coordinators for their efforts.

Piers: President Gallagher noted two large expenditures that need to be made by the end of the fiscal year: several large sections of bubbler system hose need to be replaced at approximately \$5/foot; and the Little Magothy pier pilings need to be replaced.

OLD BUSINESS:

Budget: The Treasurer, Governor Berley, and Budget Committee member, Lou Biondi, presented the BOG with the proposed SCBD FY-2012 Budget. After discussion, a motion was made and unanimously approved to present this budget to the membership at the October 27, 2010 Quarterly Membership meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

Several beautiful photographs were submitted and reviewed for selection for the 2011 Cape Calendar. The BOG selected photographs for first and second places.

A motion was made and unanimously approved for the Board to go into a Closed Session meeting immediately after the regular meeting to discuss issues that may be legal in nature.


