







Hilltop Road-Little Magothy View Intersection




Project Scope – Pedestrian Facilities

- Sidewalk on east side
 - Starts south of Woodland Circle
 - Ends at the park, connects to shopping center
- Hiker / Biker Trail on west side
 - Connects to Broadneck Trail at south end
 - Connects to park and shopping center on north end
 - Relocation of Guardhouse and Community Signs
- Pedestrian Crossing at Hilltop Road

Project Scope – Environmental

- Drainage
- Treatment / Stormwater Management
- Reforestation



Project Benefits – Road Work

The project will improve the following:

- Safety along Cape Saint Claire Road
 - Added shoulders
 - Improved sight distances
- Access for emergency vehicles
- Intersection operations at Hilltop Road
- Pedestrian and cyclist access
- Roadway drainage and treatment

Project Scope – Water Main



Project Scope -Water Main

- Starts at Forest Terrace
- Ends 500 feet northeast of Little Magothy View
- Stubs at every side street in between for future waterline construction

Waterline will be 12" in diameter



Five New Fire Hydrants

- Across from 1419 Cape St. Claire Rd.
- Across from 1433 Cape St. Claire Rd.
- Fire House
- Shopping Center (2)



Project Benefits – Water Main

- Fire protection
 - New fire hydrants
 - Connection for Fire Department
- House connections
 - Alternative if well fails
 - Not required
- Connection at shopping center

Construction Schedule

- Construction Schedule and Work Hours
 - Duration of Project
 - March 24 December 29, 2014 (280 calendar days)
- Hours of work
 - No work on weekends, nights, holidays may be exceptions
 - Lane Closures Single lane operations with flagging
 - M-F, 9 AM to 2 PM, school days
 - M-F, 9 AM to 3 PM, non-school days
 - Work outside of roadway
 - M-F, 7 AM to 6 PM
 - Includes anything that does not impact the flow of traffic

Construction Schedule

What to Expect

- Overall Construction Sequence for Road and Water Main Work
 - Road, pedestrian and water work concurrent
 - First the west side (southbound), working northward
 - Then the east side (northbound), working northward
 - Step Pool, at Fire Department, to be completed last
- What does a lane closure mean to traffic?
 - Vehicle queue will be minimized
 - No lane closures during rush hour, school dismissal
 - Check social media for timely updates
