Dear Anne Arundel County Resident:

This is to advise you that Anne Arundel County is preparing to construct the above-referenced environmental restoration project. The County has authorized PayDirt to improve the stormwater outfall near your property. This outfall is a County maintained outfall. Within the next month or two, PayDirt will begin the necessary stakeouts and preparation for construction. The construction will center on the outfall channel located at the northern edge of Cape Saint Claire Park, across from the shopping center, and will access the channel off of Cape St. Claire Road.

The work to be performed will consist of stabilizing and restoring the channel to meet the Chesapeake Bay and local restoration goals and ensuring its meets current codes and standards. This will serve to improve the overall functionality of the channel, lower the County's maintenance costs, and improve the water quality treatment component of the channel which ultimately discharges to the Magothy River. Upon completion of construction, the County will continue to maintain the channel.

We are asking for your cooperation with Anne Arundel County and PayDirt personnel, who will work near your property as needed to access the channel. All field crews will have proper identification and be properly supervised. Personnel are anticipated to be in the area until early August 2018.
